### **Boys’ Reports**

In next Friday’s end of term envelopes will be your son’s end of year report. As next week’s newsletter looks like being a long one, here are a few things to do with the Grade 3 to 7 reports:-

- a. Due to the Grade 7 boys already writing numerous exams this term, they were not examined on all the internal Content subjects; so, there are no marks or comments for subjects such as Heritage Studies.
- b. Parents need to look at their son’s marks in all subjects in relation to the class and grade averages. This will indicate how well your son is doing in that particular subject compared to the rest of the class/grade.
- c. The “Classwork Effort” symbol is how hard your son worked in class this term. It has **NOTHING** to do with the exam results.
- d. The Specialist subject comments were written by the Specialist teachers who taught your son that particular subject.

If there are any queries regarding anything to do with your son’s report, it is imperative that you make an appointment to see the class teacher.

All Hartmann House parents have been sent letters, information and documentation to do with the Alliance Health Medical Aid Scheme, which the College will be part of in 2024.

We need parents to present their current medical aid cards to Mrs Maunze next week, if you and your son(s) **are** covered by medical aid and you are not joining the Alliance Scheme.

Those parents whose sons are **NOT** covered by medical aid or any parents who wish to join the scheme, to complement their existing medical aid scheme, must fill in and return the “Student Details Form” to Mrs Maunze by Friday next week.
